

Australian Customs Notice No. 2025/16

Increase to Biosecurity Cost Recovery Charge

This Notice advises of changes to the biosecurity cost recovery charge on Full Import Declarations (FIDs) for goods arriving in Australia by air and sea, and replaces <u>Australian Customs Notice 2024/22</u> - Increase to <u>Biosecurity Cost Recovery Charge</u>.

From 1 July 2025, the biosecurity cost recovery charge for goods arriving by air and sea will be increased to \$46.00 and \$68.00, respectively. This only applies to imported goods with a customs value over AUD1000.

The Australian Border Force collects the biosecurity cost recovery charge through the Integrated Cargo System, on behalf of the Department of Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry (DAFF). The new charge rates, reflected in the table below, will apply to imports from 1 July 2025.

Charge	Current charge	New charge from 1 July 2025	Who is affected?
Full Import Declaration charge – air	AUD45	AUD46	Customs brokers and importers of consignments over AUD1000
Full Import Declaration charge – sea	AUD66	AUD68	Customs brokers and importers of consignments over AUD1000
